

100% increase in subsidy on bread and guaranteed purchase of wheat in the budget bill

A member of the House Budget, Budget and Accounts Commission says the sources of targeted subsidies in the budget bill , which includes three rows of spending, including bread subsidies, student nutrition and cash subsidies.

Gholam Ali Jafarzadeh Aymanabadi, member of the Parliament's Planning, Budgeting and Accounting Commission on Resources and Expenditures of the Subsidies Targeting Organization, said: The organization's resources are defined in 3 rows per year; From export sales of petroleum products from export of gasoline, from domestic sales of natural gas, from electricity and water to customers, from power plants, from petrochemical gas condensate.

Rasht people's representative in the Islamic Consultative Assembly added: in the year of about 6 trillion tomans credit for subsidies is projected that this figure will increase to 99 trillion for the year 99 so the sources of subsidy targeting law will increase by 5% Much of this growth is driven by gasoline exports and rising gas prices.

He stated: Targeted Subsidies Organization Spends Resources in Four Tiers; Taxes, VAT and Share of Related Companies, Cash and Non-cash Subsidies to Families, Reduction of Absolute Household Poverty, Article 6 of the Law Incorporation; Subjects to reduce health costs, bread subsidies and guaranteed wheat purchases; other objectives set forth in Sixth Plan; Student Welfare, Production and Employment Subject to Clause A of Note 18 Budget Bill; and Other Targeted Goals

Described in Schedule Sections 1 and 2 of the government's general budget include the expenditure targeting organization.

The Government added in the 10th Majlis: The Government shall, in the course of the year, implement the Livelihoods, Nutrition and Welfare of Students Program, Production and Employment subject to Clause 18 of the Budget Bill; It does not use the \$ 6 billion in resources deriving from the targeted subsidy law, meaning that the credits for these programs are zero.
