

# Launching Strategic Warehouses with 200,000 tons of capacity in the near future

Modarres Khiyabani said: Ship mooring has been done in Chabahar for a while and now the main need is storage centers for this kind of goods, meaning we need silos, oil tanks and refrigerated storage to store and store these fortunately. Al-Quds has a series of semi-finished infrastructure and about two hundred thousand tonnes of roofed warehouses will be set up soon.

Hossein Modarres Khiyabani, referring to the main purpose of our trip to the flooded areas of Sistan and Baluchestan province, said: "During our visit to these areas, we have provided basic commodities and basic necessities for flood victims and also Part of the livestock input has also been provided, which will continue.

The Deputy Minister of Industry, Mining and Commerce in the Ministry of Commerce added: In recent days, significant quantities of basic commodities, including sugar, oil, rice and flour, have been provided to the provincial crisis headquarters to supply the basic needs of the people in these areas. Coordinated by the governors of the area, it is being distributed and given that the farms have been destroyed, livestock feeds have been provided so that existing livestock will not be harmed.

Modarres Khiyabani added in another part: It has been a while since Chabahar ships have been evacuated to dump essential goods and now the main need is to maintain these types of goods, meaning we need silos, oil tanks and cold storage for

evacuation and maintenance. Fortunately, the warehouses of the Holy Cross have a number of semi-finished infrastructures, and about two hundred thousand tons of roofed warehouses will be set up soon.
