

Rising wheat prices will not be effected

Sa'adati Kia said the increase in the purchase price of wheat will not be effected due to the fact we are nearing the end of the purchase season of this product.

According to the public relations of Iran's government-owned corporation, Morteza Saadati Kia, general manager of Iran's domestic purchasing coordination on Iranian wheat prices, said that some farmers were keeping their wheat in line with the increase in wheat prices or delivered it to shopping centers with delay.

He added that there seems to be no increase in wheat prices this year. Therefore, it is expected that the Council of the Economy will increase the price of wheat in accordance with the law by the end of September and will announce new rates for the coming crop, so farmers do not have to worry about this.

The Director General for Internal Domestic Purchasing Coordination has continued: since the beginning of the harvest season, five million and 10 thousand wheat worth eight thousand and 684 billion tomans have been purchased by the state purchasing centers, of which 4 million and 857 thousand tons of purchase information to the bank Agriculture has been posted.

He said wheat purchases were filed in farmers' accounts on July 16th at the Agricultural Bank Purchase System showing a total of seven thousand 275 billion tomans.

The director of the coordinating department of domestic purchasing of Iran's state-owned corporation, saying that wheat purchase is guaranteed throughout the country, said Khuzestan with a million and 300 thousand tons, Fars 562 thousand tons, Golestan 564 thousand tons, Khorasan Razavi 370 thousand tons, and Kermanshah 340 thousand first rank first to fifth in purchasing wheat.

Katie added that wheat purchasing was guaranteed according to the cleanliness table, including good loss, unprofitable loss and age. Therefore, according to the Economic Council's decision, every kilogram of ordinary wheat, with a loss of four hundred percent, and one percent of the unattractive should be purchased at T 1,700 and durum wheat, is T 1,770. On average, one kilogram of bread wheat is purchased at an average price of 736 T
